## **Environment '07 Conference Keynote Speakers**

### ***Opening Address: Tuesday, March 13th***

**Rocky Marcoux**, Commissioner, Dept of City Development, *City of Milwaukee*

Rocky Marcoux was appointed Commissioner of Milwaukee's Department of City Development in 2004. He served as a senior staff member of the Housing Authority for the City of Milwaukee since 1986. His housing developments incorporate accessibility and sustainable development practices. He has received accolades for putting a green roof on Highland Gardens housing development in Milwaukee - now the largest residential application in the Midwest. A graduate of Marquette University, he is a member of the Congress for the New Urbanism, the American Planning Association, the Urban Land Institute and the National Association of Housing & Redevelopment Officials.



### ***Luncheon Keynote: Tuesday, March 13th***

**John Gurda**, Historian and Author

John Gurda is a Milwaukee-born writer and historian who is the author of fifteen books, on subjects ranging from life insurance to Frank Lloyd Wright and from heavy industries to historic cemeteries. His latest, *The Making of Milwaukee* is his most ambitious effort and the first feature-length history of the community published since 1948. Gurda is also a lecturer, tour guide and local history columnist for the *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel*. He holds a B.A. in English from Boston College and an M.A. in Cultural Geography from UW-Milwaukee. Gurda is an eight-time winner of the Wisconsin Historical Society's Award of Merit.

**Sean Ryan**, Journalist, *The Daily Reporter*

Sean Ryan has worked for *The Daily Reporter* since 2000, when he covered the state Legislature in an internship with the paper's Madison bureau. He's been working as a full-time staff writer at the Milwaukee office since 2002. He received a journalism degree from UW-Madison, and has received numerous awards including a Milwaukee Press Club's first place award for his coverage of We Energies' Power the Future proposal, and the National Newspaper Association's first place Best Business Story Award for co-writing about Wisconsin's biotechnology industry. He has also served as contributing editor and writer for Aspen Publications, and as copy editor for UW-Madison's Center for Integrated Agricultural Systems.
