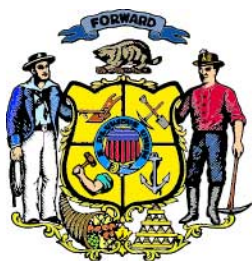


# The Twenty-Second Annual Governor's Award for Excellence in Environmental Performance

To be presented on March 11, 2008 at

The Award Program is open to all state industries, institutions, businesses, and government entities sponsoring or operating environmental performance programs of outstanding quality.



The Governor is looking for companies, organizations or businesses that:

- Used in-plant practices to increase environmental performance
- Turned their garbage into gold
- Discovered their wastes were costing them money-and did something about it
- Kept toxic materials from becoming hazardous wastes or wastes from becoming hazardous
- Replaced hazardous materials in processes and products
- Designed new products using minimal amounts of toxics in manufacture and producing minimal hazardous waste.

The Award will recognize achievements in environmental performance in Wisconsin, based on the following criteria:

- Reduction of the degree and amount of waste toxicity, emissions, or other environmental performance
- Economic performance as measured by profits generated, costs reduced and payback periods
- Transferability of the processes or techniques to similar applications for use by other industries, organizations or institutions
- Commitment, by the applicant, to help other industries, organizations or institutions by sharing information and expertise.

Eligible projects include, but are not limited to:

- Changes in production processes or materials which promote the use of non-hazardous materials or reduce the total amount of waste or increase environmental performance
- Processes which recover energy or raw materials from wastes

## Nomination Information

Anyone, including individuals, corporations, organizations and institutions, may submit nominations. The applicant's environmental compliance status will be considered in determination of eligibility. All applications will be considered public information. Qualifying projects must be in place and fully operational by December 1, 2007. All nominations must be received by December 3, 2007 to qualify for the 2008 award.

## Applications must include the following:

- Name, title, address and telephone number of individual submitting nomination
- Name, title, address, telephone number of owner or operator, and CEO (or other appropriate contact person) of nominated project
- A brief description of the corporation, institution or other entity operating the project, including, if appropriate, product or service, number of employees and history
- A 500-word (maximum) summary of the project, including previous conditions, technology or substitutions used, economic returns, methods of measuring change, applicability for other industries, environmental benefits and efforts made to share information. Be sure to explain how the project meets each of the four criteria.
